

Post-operative care of small furries

Your pet should be prevented from becoming cold.

Keeping a you pet at room temperature is adequate.

If there is a wound, do not use sawdust as bedding, but use shredded newspaper instead, until the healing is complete.

Supply food and water as normal, appropriate to the species, with clean hay at all times.

We use Isoflurane Anaesthesia, which is much safer for small furries and leaves them brighter, with less hangover!

In general, food pellets should only be provided for part of the day, with hay always available, to help prevent teeth over-growing.
